
**Countertop washbasin**  
– installation instructions




**Note!** Before installation of the countertop washbasin, install and level the countertop.



1. Position the washbasin at the target location on the countertop and make its outline with a pencil.
2. Mark the opening on the countertop for the washbasin plug.




**3.** Remove the washbasin from the countertop. The outer outline and the opening for the plug should be clearly visible.




**4. OPTIONAL STEP FOR WASHBASINS WITH A TAP INSTALLATION OPENING.**


Position the washbasin downside up on the countertop, aligning it with the outline. Mark the opening on the countertop for the tap.



**5.** Remove the washbasin and use a hole cutter to drill the openings in the places marked on the countertop.




**6.** Protect the openings with silicone sealant.




**7. OPTIONAL STEP FOR WASHBASINS WITH A TAP INSTALLATION OPENING.**


Install the tap.




**8.** Install the washbasin plug.




**9.** Apply silicone sealant to the washbasin bottom and the countertop.



**10.** Place the prepared washbasin on the countertop.



**11.** Make sure that the edge between the washbasin and the countertop is tightly sealed.



**12.** Install the washbasin trap.

## **Care and maintenance**

Flush with clean water and wipe with a dry, soft cloth.

For heavier deposits, it is recommended to use special tap cleaning agents, preferably professional Oltens products from the NanoCare and NanoShine series.

Never use agents containing alcohol, disinfectants, solvents and strong bases.

Never clean the surface of the tap with rough cloths or cleaning agents containing abrasive materials and acids.
